Dharmakshetra has been by now a witness to innumerable miracles of Bhagawan Baba. So many materializations, curing of serious ailments, transformations of hearts and most importantly being a personal witness to Bhagawan's total command over nature.

One interesting anecdote is worth mentioning here wherein His total control over nature was witnessed by me personally. It was the month of July when Baba was in Bombay. The Sai Organisation of Bombay had arranged a Public meeting at Dharmakshetra in honour of Baba. It was a Sunday evening. The meeting was to commence at six. At 5.15 p.m. the sky was fully overcast and the office bearers feared that rain might lash at any time. Out of their anxiety to avoid trouble for the large number of devotees, some of them felt that they should request Baba to commence the meeting half an hour early. I felt Baba might not accede to their prayer since Rahukalam would end only at six. However, my colleagues in the Sai Organisation insisted that there was nothing like Rahukalam for Bhagwan and they should go ahead with their request to Him.

I went up to Bhagawan and prayed. "Baba, could we start the meeting a little early?" "Why" asked Baba in a tone, which by itself was an answer to my question.

But I failed to understand the purport of Baba's question; and pleaded with Him, "Swami, it is likely to rain. The meeting may get disrupted and the devotees may suffer."

Baba smiled sympathetically; He held my hand and took me to the nearby window from where I could see the drizzling had already started. I could see through the window the entire crowd gathered below and the dark overcast sky. Baba said, "Yes, yes, it will rain heavily".

Baba's statements made me more nervous. I was searching for words to pray to Baba. Meanwhile, Baba put His hand outside through the window and raised it towards the sky. In a moment, the drizzle stopped and the clouds started dispersing! In that moment of anxiety, the extraordinary act of Bhagawan did not have any impact on me. Baba said, "We will commence the meeting at six as announced." I came down rushing to convey Baba's command to my colleagues. The meeting began at six and the sky had brightened enough to dispel all their fears. It was during the meeting that I realized what a great blunder I had committed by praying to Baba to commence the meeting early. I had forgotten the truth that Baba is God and that He has full command over Nature. When the meeting ended, I rushed with tears of joy to see Baba and fell at His feet. Baba looked at me and said; "You forgot"! That was one of the most unforgettable moments for me in my life and this is one incident which has been imprinted into my mind and soul and will remain till the end of time.

I am happy that Bhagawan has just recently instructed us to convert "DHARMAKSHETRA" into a TEERTH STHAN by raising the level of the spiritual vibrations within it and by beautifying it so that not only the citizen's of Bombay but the world over would feel elevated and get spiritually charged during their visit to DHARMAKSHETRA and fulfill their spiritual aspirations in their life's journey.

Truly, we must admit that it has been our good fortune to have such a monument of the Sai saga in Mumbai and be the recipients thereby of Bhagawan's abundant Love and Blessings. Let us all unite together and endeavour to transform DHARMAKSHETRA to a TEERTH STHAN as willed by Bhagawan.
