The foundation stone was laid by the International Chairman of Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, Shri Indulal Shah.



Sri Sathya Sai Institute Of Agriculture And Biotechnology

This unique Institute offers a comprehensive training course for empowerment of the rural youth. Young unemployed men from farming families with marginal land holdings are selected from villages of Maharashtra and given training in modern scientific methods of agriculture and biotechnology, post harvest technology and Nutraceuticals, Water management, biofertilizers and soil Rejuvenation, Medicinal Plants and Herbal Medicines, Preventive and Social Medicine and Education in Human Values. This is a 30 day training course, with a further extension for a period of 15 days for undergoing intensive practical course.

The facilities available for the training include an aesthetic meditation centre, a beautiful bioclimatically designed pyramid shaped Institute building having facilities for training and research, classrooms, laboratories for tissue culture and biofertilizers, solar drying, Green house /Net house and Demonstration farm, etc.
