Sri Sathya Sai Annapurna Scheme has targeted to provide nutritious meal to the needy and hungry on a mass-scale in the Adivasi Villages of Maharashtra. A corpus has been created to enable this scheme to become an ongoing Seva.

Sai Prem

Sai Prem is a visible extension of Dharmakshetra in Navi Mumbai (New Bombay). The foundation stone was laid at the hands of Sri Indulal Shah, the then Chairman of World Council, in 1994. The construction of the building was completed in May 1995. On 13th May 1995, Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba consecrated the building for His Devotees.
